Gist of the article	<p>Although stem cells do not promise to offer a solution which would lead to eternal youth, these could, according to doctors, effectively help in ushering in an era of non-surgical cosmetic treatments.</p> <p>As per claims of a Harley Street clinic, which has been busy carrying out the world's first ever stem cells facelifts, the results have been very impressive. Instead of putting the patient under the knife and cutting and pulling the skin, the new procedure takes fat and stem cells from the flabby parts of a patient's body and injects them to fill out the face.</p> <p>The very simple treatment takes a mere 5 hours and can be easily carried out under local anesthesia. The procedure has been pioneered by Dr. Aamer Khan, a cosmetic surgeon working with the Harley Street Medical Skin Clinic in London. The cost is 7,500 Pounds per treatment, and according to Dr. Khan, the procedure not only helps patients look younger by "adding volume" to the face, but also "repairs and rejuvenates skin for up to 18 months".</p> <p>So far, Dr. Khan has worked on 18 women and results have been really good</p>
